

RECUT, RESEW, REUSE SMALL QUILT CHALLENGE

Recut, resew, and/or redesign this wonderful *Sunflower Star* block. See photo's below.
Bought on Ebay, this quilt top looked exciting with all the varied color combinations.
Unfortunately, it was poorly sewn and unappealing as a practice piece for machine quilting.
The block is probably made from sheets from the 1970's. It is roughly 18" square.

Guidelines for this challenge:

1. Pay \$5.00 per block.
2. Reuse at least % of the fabric in the block OR use 1 of the fabric in the block plus any other fabric from 1970's era sheets.
3. Finished size can be 12 to 15.5 inches square.
4. Any other fabric or embellishments must be recycled items.

Viewers will be asked to vote for their favorite block based on the following criteria.

1. Best use of fabric in the original block.
(Finished block will be displayed next to a picture of the original block.)
2. Best use of color.
3. Favorite design.

Prizes will be awarded.
There are only 20 blocks available. First come, first choice.
