## Marcia Stein – Destinations: Travel-Inspired Quilts




Marcia Stein is a San Francisco textile artist whose award-winning work has been shown in a number of juried exhibitions at galleries, museums, and quilt shows throughout the country and is included in several public and private collections.

Originally from Chicago, Marcia is a graduate of the University of Michigan in Ann Arbor. She took up quilting in 1992, after a lifelong interest in other needle arts, and has been pursuing her interest in textile art full-time since 1996.

For the past few years, Marcia has been working on a series of large-scale pictorial quilts based on her travel photographs. We'll journey with her to Santa Fe, Italy, England, and the South of France, where she will show us her favorite scenes and tells how she created the quilts they inspired. A trunk show will be included.

### 2015 Small Quilt Crayola Challenge

Each participant will draw two crayons from a bag, starting at the August General meeting. Those colors and their various shades will be the only colors allowed for your fabrics and embellishments. The theme is the maker's choice. The quilt must be 15" x 20" with either a vertical or horizontal orientation. The quilt must have a top, batting, and back (3 layers). The maker may use any quilt method. The actual crayons must be attached to the front of the quilt, either temporarily or permanently. Entry forms will be available on the GQG website. Acceptance begins December 1, 2014. **Entry Deadline:** February 11, 2015. Awards will be given for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place. All quilts will hang at the 2015 Glendale Quilt Guild Show.



We are almost ready to release our Longarm Challenge for the 2015 Show! This Challenge is open to everyone, not just members, so let's all get the word out!



In this Challenge, all participants will be working with the same small quilt top Provided by the Guild. Choose your own batting, back and thread.

- ⇒ The size of the quilt is 20 x 20.
- ⇒ Quilting must be hand-guided long armed by one person; not computerized.
- ⇒ Judging will be based on your quilting design, difficulty, and execution, as well as overall workmanship
- ⇒ Awards will be presented for 1st, 2nd, 3rd places, plus two Honorable Mentions.
- ⇒ The challenge will be limited to the first 20 entries accepted.
- ⇒ Cost to enter the Longarm Challenge is \$10.00, which covers the cost of the top.
- ⇒ Entry acceptance begins December 1, 2014; Deadline is January 12, 2015.

- MEMBERSHIP: (Griffin) Membership renewal process continues. August is the cutoff date for inclusion in the Roster. Nan will help draft the Roster.
- NEWSLETTER: (Spinn) Deadline: August 18.
- 2015 SHOW: (Emmons) Next Show Meeting is Sept 16, 6:30 at Citibank in Montrose. Need volunteers for: Guild Boutique, Program (creation-typing), Signs, Workshop Teacher "Wrangler." Crayola Challenge will be available at the Membership meeting. Longarm Challenge is developing. All are welcome.
- 2016 SHOW: (Wilson) Nothing new at this point.
- LOVING HANDS: (Golditch) We have a big bag of fabric from one of our favorite anonymous donor. Sent 6 quilts to children's hospital of Colorado in Aurora, CO as a result of a request from Barbara Stuart whose 8 year old relative is undergoing cancer treatment there and has appointed himself as a one-boy Make a Wish committee. Delivered 100 to County USC.
- BLOCK OF THE MONTH: (Maples) Instructions have been posted to the Guild website for Rubber Duckie Junction. People attending a workshop will receive a printed copy. 8 attended first Rubber Duckie Club workshop in July. Next: Aug 23. Remind people to sign up and pay through Workshops at the general meeting.
- HOSPITALITY: (Shier) Position filled by Susan Heine. She will perform as a Coordinator who will make sure there is a Hospitality Hostesses for each month. This will start in September. Coordinator will submit an explanatory article for the Newsletter.
- PHILANTHROPY: (Shier) Position filled by Joni Kellam. Mernie Meier shared a thank you note from San Jose Museum of quilts & Textiles for our \$500 donation.

### OLD BUSINESS:

- (Bradfield) FCC is holding the Fellowship Hall for July 11, 2015 SCCQG meeting. Errors in the proposed contract are being addressed.
- (Fogel) We are keeping changes to current website to a minimum. Current estimate is \$6760 against a budget of \$7500. Hosting current cost is \$70 per year. Future will be \$159 for 2 years. This is included in the monthly invoice which is included in the website maintenance. New website will use Content Management System, templates (faster build and updates), faster and better systems, and manages content to be sized correctly for all devices. It is will be designed for better use of space and we will have about one fifth more room and can build horizontally.
- (Fogel) 2015 Program - APR and MAY have contracts. APR 2016 Renee Merrill will be here from the east. JUL 2015 there will be program but no workshop.

(1 Against) Theft Insurance: Discussion on advisability of renewal of theft insurance policy given the stated restrictions of the underwriter.
